

Veterans Journey Home

This documentary offers a unique perspective on the "Hero's Journey," focusing not on the traditional tales of battlefield heroism, but rather on the inner battle these veterans face as they strive to find emotional and psychological peace with the aftermath of their past actions and decisions. Their struggle is a different kind of courage—one that requires confronting deep emotional pain, trauma, and self-doubt, rather than bullets or bombs. The series uncovers the hidden struggles many veterans face, from feelings of loss, rage, and betrayal, to moments of intense fear and self-loathing. Through these intimate stories, we gain a deeper understanding of the emotional journey that soldiers must undertake as they return to civilian life. Across racial, cultural, and gender lines, these veterans—men and women, African Americans, Latinos, and more—share their raw and unfiltered experiences. Directed by Oscar® and Emmy® nominated filmmaker Frederick Marx ("Hoop Dreams"), this documentary brings to light the personal, courageous battles veterans fight after their time in combat, not on the frontlines, but within themselves.



Solutions for Veterans Returning Home (15' HD)

This short documentary explains the philosophy behind the entire five film series, showing how relatively simple it can be to shepherd veterans back toward wholeness and productivity. The greatest minds in veterans healing highlight community-based, non-medicalized solutions for veterans returning home.



The Story of Marine Captain Kalani - His Struggles & Fierce Determination to Battle Inner Demons (30' HD)

Marine Captain Kalani Creutzburg experiences transformation through emotionally authentic healing circles. He battles with suicide, homelessness, prescription drugs, and depression until he finds a way back toward wholeness with a new mission to guide his civilian journey. Kalani attends a Healing Warrior Hearts retreat then uses his introduction to "healing work" to uncork his long bottled-up feelings and guide him toward a new mission in life—serving homeless veterans. Once back home in San Diego, he fulfills his vision of establishing a permanent home for homeless veterans as he undertakes a brutal 225-mile trek to raise money to buy a working ranch.



On Black Mountain - The Transformation of Women Veterans through Mindfulness Healing (49' HD)

This documentary follows the transformation of 22 women veterans through mindfulness-based healing. This documentary teaches the tools of meditation and sensory awareness to confront military sexual trauma and the ghosts of war, regrounding themselves in sisterhood and community.



Ben's Story: Former Army Paratrooper & Sniper Turns His Life Around (53' HD)

Challenged by suicidal ideation, divorce, and alcoholism, Ben fights to reconnect with his family and resume a place of leadership in civilian society. Filmed over a 2-year period, the story begins after Ben has gotten out of the hospital following a drunken bar fight that almost killed him. Knowing he needs to turn his life around, but skeptical of doing anything emotional, he attends a workshop in Milwaukee called Healing Warrior Hearts. The film tracks his slow growth into acceptance of his feelings, ending years later with his participation at Healing Warrior Hearts and taking a volunteer role at a Ranch in Wisconsin—tending to horses and teaching special needs children how to ride.



Leaving it on the Land - 12 Suicidal Veterans & Their Healing Journey (80' HD)

This documentary features 12 suicidal veterans as they undergo an ancient 12 day Vision Fast ceremony—out in the wilderness with minimal shelter, fasting, alone—each seeks their personal transformation and healing journey.

Intimately exploring universal themes of dreams, sacrifice, love, family, loss, and determination, the film ultimately reveals the elusive alchemy of finding one's purpose in life.



Fritz

Arts / Social • 60' HD

When Ben and Mike discover Fritz, he's hit a tough patch in life. His girlfriend of ten years, Darlene, recently passed away. He has a tumultuous relationship with his brother Vince, who thinks his dreams of being a professional artist are foolish and unabashedly throws his failures in his face. Lastly, Fritz's hearing issues cause him to struggle in social situations. He has few friends. They photograph Fritz and his work and convince him to build a new art studio in his rundown basement. Finally, they take a road trip to NYC to visit a huge art fair and show Fritz how America has turned fine art collecting into a shopping mall experience. A surprise twist ending reveals what making it in the artworld is all about.



Soar

Arts / Social • 60' HD

Kiera, a determined young woman and quadruple amputee since childhood, fights against stereotype and physical expectations as she fulfills her desire to dance and choreograph. All the while, her younger sister Uriah, who has long been both muse and best friend, struggles with the need to fulfill her own independent life and identity. Filmmaker Susan Hess Logeais is drawn into their journey, documenting the strain on their relationship as they pursue their separate paths and grow apart. In the end, their shared love of dance draws the sisters back together, healing their deep bond.



Rebels on Pointe

Arts / Social • 60' HD or 90' HD

This is the first film ever made about the world-famous Ballet Trockadero de Monte Carlo. The New York based drag ballet company—commonly known as The Trocks—is made up of professional gay dancers who all play both feminine and male roles in classical ballet pieces—and they do it with amazing talent, grace, and brilliant parody of Russian Imperial ballet. The film goes behind-the-scenes into their professional and dramatic personal lives, revealing powerful dance performances in multiple locations around the world, including revived choreographies of a Russian era which expertly combine humour and impeccable technique. The dancers share stories about growing up, being gay, and the many challenges and obstacles they faced to become professional ballerinas.



PAN! Our Music Odyssey

Against the backdrop of Trinidad and Tobago's annual steel band competition, Panorama—in which thousands of musicians in huge ensembles of over 100 players desperately compete in performing elaborate music—several musicians chase their dreams. Their stories are interlaced with re-enactments of the rags-to-riches tale of the steel band movement, which was born into poverty and violence but climbed to the highest levels of social and artistic acceptance. This film is the story of men and women who staked all on their art, and of French, Japanese and Americans, whose passion and daring has drawn them to the world championships. The Ship Sinkers

Congo's Call of the Wild

Salonga National Park is Africa's biggest rainforest. An estimated 80,000 elephants once roamed Salonga's forests, but after decades of poaching, only 1,800 elephants remain, with the forest largely intact but fading. A Congolese/American/French team travels to the heart of Salonga, to see how rangers and conservationists are trying to save this biological treasure, including an endangered and endemic species of apes called bonobos. Will their long, dangerous trek lead to these rare bonobos being saved? A call to action is heard and the wheels are set in motion to save the precious Congo and its inhabitants.



Saving the Mustang:

North America's Horse on the Brink of Extinction

Wild mustangs have long been an icon of native peoples and early settlers of North America. Yet their fate today is uncertain. 
